Cloth Masks for Use in the Community

All Staff,

You are being given three cloth face masks to wear for source control while you and/or your family are out in the community.

Two of the masks come with a filter piece to provide an extra layer of protection (for filter info contact Nancy). The filter can be removed if it's too hard breathe through, and easily reinserted if desired. These masks, with or without the filter are only to be used as source control. They are not PPE.

All staff should continue to wear the blue surgical masks while at work for the best protection against COVID-19. In an effort to conserve our current supply of surgical masks we ask that you re-wear your surgical mask for up to three days. Keep them in a paper bag between uses.

How to receive your cloth masks: Pick up your cloth masks from the old break room. Do NOT touch other staff masks.

How to wash this homemade mask:

These masks should be washed when soiled or hard to breathe through.

Directions for washing cloth mask and/or filter:

- 1) Launder in the washing machine with hot water. Slide cord lock tight to the mask before washing.
- 2) Dry the masks in the dryer or allow to air dry. Re-Shape as needed
- 3) DO NOT MICROWAVE YOUR MASKS!!!!! EVER!!!! They have metal inside of them that will cause a fire.
